## **White House Pocket Constitution**

Amended he United States Constitution

I. Commander-in-Chief WE, THE PEOPLE, of the United States, in order to form a more perfect Union, establishjustice, insure domestic tranquility; provide for the common defense, promote the general welfare, and secure the blessings of liberty to ourselves and our posterity, do ordain to establish this Constitution for the United States of America.

Article I: See Article II

Article II: COMMANDER-in-CHIEF!

The President is Commander-in-Chief of America. He shall have power. by and with the advice and consent of the Senate. to make treaties he may break those treaties for reasons of his choosing. He shall take care that the laws by which he chooses to abide be faithfully executed at his discretion.

Articles III - VII: See Article II

## Abridged The Bill of Rights:

Amendment I: Congress shall respect an establishment of religion and the abridgment of speech, of press, and the right of the people peaceably to assemble. subject to national security demands.

Amendment II: A well-regulated militia, being necessary to the security of a free State, the right of the people to keep and bear arms, shall not be infringed.

Amendment III: No Soldier shall, in time of peace be quartered in any house, without the consent of the Owner, nor in time of war, but in a manner to be prescribed by law. We love British troops!

Amendment IV: Persons, their papers and effects way be secured by the government in their houses or elsewhere. The government's right to carry out unreasonable searches and seizures shall not be infringed.

Amendment V: Do you want the terrorists to win???

Should someone actually be charged with a crime might Amendment VI: In all criminal prosecutions, the accused shall enjoy the right to a speedy and public trial, by an impartial jury, and to be informed of the nature and cause of the accusation, and to have the assistance of counsel for his defense, the Department of Defense

Amendment VII: Technicality...

Amendment VIII: See Amendment V

XXX

Amendment IX: The enumeration in the Constitution, of certain rights, shall not be construed to deny or disparage others retained by the people. shall be FINAL.

Amendment X: The powers not delegated to the United States by the Constitution, nor prohibited by it to the States, are reserved to the <u>States respectively</u>, or to the people.
