

50 MILLION LIVES DEPEND ON THE NEXT SUPREME COURT APPOINTMENT!

Some may think that the confirmation of Judge Roberts as the Chief Justice of our Supreme Court was the president's most important political victory of his presidency. But let us in the Pro-Life community not deceive ourselves: this great judge is at best an able replacement for the late Chief Justice William Rehnquist -- meaning that we "broke-even" with his conformation. To actually overturn the horrific Roe v. Wade (and other related) decisions, we need at least one more solid conservative and preferably two. That means that Present Bush's current nominee is the really crucial one.

Obviously his appointment of Harriet Miers was a failed choice for this vital seat. But this current candidate for this crucial position must be someone who is comparable to Chief Justice Roberts in judicial competency, and a true ideological conservative who will significantly move the Court in OUR DIRECTION! And President Bush has made that outstanding decision!

7-PAC is praising the president for having the courage to nominate a truly outstanding conservative, Judge Samuel A. Alito, Jr. of the Third US Circuit Court of Appeals, to be that key conservative to fill the Supreme Court seat being vacated by the retiring Associate Justice Sandra Day O'Conner. Judge Alito is a true conservative; a dynamic jurist who will do much good for many years if he is given the opportunity by President Bush (and you and me) to serve in this vital leadership role!

The urgency of President Bush's this appointment cannot be overstated. It is this next judge who will move the Court in a consistently conservative direction. President Bush has nominated a Judge in the mold of Justice Antonin Scalia or Justice Clarence Thomas. He is a true conservative with the ideological muscle to face down the abortion lobby -- who are responsible for this tragedy that has been dogging America for the last 30 years.

Now let's add some perspective before we talk politics...and create our action steps:

The 20th Century was a century of war, and WWII was the most costly of all in both human lives and treasure. Some 50 million persons died (including all belligerents and bystanders -- all military deaths and civilian deaths). All deaths from all war-related causes from September 1939 through August of 1945 total about 50 million persons.

Next consider that the American phase of the Vietnam War began fifteen years after the end of WWII -- and we are still in turmoil over the 60,000 Americans died between 1960 and 1975. Adding to these deaths are the 90,000 French who died in the first phase of that conflict from 1945 through 1954; and the approximately 3 million Vietnamese who died during the whole thirty years. Thus the totals for the whole Vietnam conflict are some 3.15 million persons.

Then compare the current death toll in the war on terrorism (including the estimated 2,500 who died on 9/11, and the approximately 2,000 American soldiers who have died in Afghanistan and Iraq these last two years). This total is about 4,500 deaths.

Now contrast these military statistics with deaths due to abortions:

- 1. ...more than 4,500 fetal and embryonic children are killed daily.
- 2. ...more than 60,000 every two weeks -- exceeding US deaths in Vietnam.
- 3. ...more than 1.4 million annually -- exceeding all US military deaths in our history.
- 4. ...since Roe v. Wade (1973): 40 to 50 million deaths -- the same as WWII.

Therefore, it is not an exaggeration to state that abortions are the greatest tragedy in American history -- by far! These deaths are all innocent -- and nearly every one has been preventable and unnecessary since 95% of women having abortions state that they are killing their children for birth control reasons.

It is said that Rev. Billy Graham stated that if God didn't judge America for its sins, He would have to apologize to Sodom and Gomorrah. Surly this will be true if we do nothing to stop abortion now -- when we can. If we just sit on the sidelines instead of stopping this terrible chapter in our history; If we don't help President Bush by letting him know that we want this practice stopped; If we don't show him that we will strongly support him when he nominates a true conservative who will vote to end Roe v. Wade and other awful high court decisions -- then we are not part of the solution...we are part of the problem.

Where should our focus be? It must be on the next 50 million innocent lives that **can** be saved! If we do nothing, part of the responsibility for the next generation of tragedy falls on us -- we Laodiceans who knew better and did nothing!

Ultra-Liberal groups like MoveOn.org, George Soros' Open Society Policy Center, People for the American Way, the American Association for Affirmative action, the homosexual Human Rights Campaign, NARAL, National Abortion Federation, National Gay and Lesbian Task Force, Planned Parenthood and dozens more are already lined up and ready to tell President Bush whom he must pick as the next Supreme court Justice.

Together, all these Far Left Liberal Groups will spend millions to defeat any Conservative Supreme Court Justice nominee. <u>WE CANNOT ALLOW THE LIBERALS</u> <u>TO WIN!!</u>
